GO AWAY, MURPHY!

Murphy's Law was in its glory this summer at The Oasis Animal Sanctuary! In addition to the typical farm mishaps like a tractor breaking and parts unavailable, wasp attacks or a fence falling down, our central air conditioning system irreparably broke during the height of the heat wave in July, and the roof started exhibiting signs of major repairs being needed immediately. Our one farmhand was out unexpectedly for a month with health problems when our other farmhand retired; and Oasis hurriedly took in 8 cats from another rescue that was shutting down, most of whom have medical issues that need special care. **Go away, Murphy!!**

On a good note, we've found adoptive homes for mama cat Gypsy and her 4 kittens, as well as 5 other kittens, and 3 adult cats - 2 of which went home together! We also took in 2 Pekin ducks that were found wandering loose in Sicklerville, NJ. Oasis also helped a small dog rescue called Safe at Home Rescue find homes for 13 of their dogs! **PLEASE NOTE THAT OASIS IS CURRENTLY NOT TAKING IN ANY DOGS.**

Sadly, we are still getting calls WEEKLY for 75 – 100 cats needing to be surrendered, but even with some great adoption figures we are still at over-capacity and understaffed. We do offer our low cost spay and neuter program to all southern New Jersey residents to at least help alleviate the pet overpopulation situation. This includes feral cats (please note we do not offer a trapping service for ferals). If Oasis can help get your pet sterilized, or assist in limiting your feral colony, please go onto our website at www.oasisanimalsanctuary.org, click on Our Work, then click on Sterilization Assistance Program. 
