THE ROLLER COASTER RIDE CONTINUES!

As in the past, this year brought many challenges to our organization, but seeing the grateful faces of the animals we've cared for is the blessing and motivator to continue. Because of so many kittens coming in sick or injured, Oasis was able to take in only 17 animals – 15 cats and kittens, 1 dog and 1 young horse. We did, however, find homes for 11 other dogs, helping out a local rescue. These new Oasis animals are in addition to the 40 already at the facility. We have thankfully adopted out a number of cats this year, with 5 more going home right after Christmas.

We had a **new duck house built**, and removed the old dilapidated structures. **Hugo's giant field was split** in two, and now Fiona is closer to all the horses and has a handsome new neighbor! We **replaced some old rundown fencing**. We have a **new farmhand** who is working out well, and we thankfully have a **few new volunteers!** Oasis even got a new fancy "Farmland Preservation" sign!

One of our Board members resigned due to changes in her home and work environments. We wish Beth Knudsen the best in her new endeavors!

This year we lost our beloved donkey **Molly** in October. Old age and bad feet did her in, and we sadly had her humanely euthanized. We also lost **Hank and Pearl** - two of our Pekin ducks - to old age and infection, as well as **Esmeralda** (chicken), **Belvedere** (equine), **Sadie** (feline), and **Andy** (canine). No matter how many times you go thru losing an animal, it never gets easier. But there is always another poor creature out there in dire need of care, and so we continue our mission.

The medical bills for the resident animals as well as all the "bottle-baby" kittens that came in with serious medical issues resulted in Oasis taking in less animals this year to cover those expenses. So again, **we are reaching out to our generous donors to please remember Oasis during the holiday season, and help our company to continue.** For example, \$9 buys a bale of hay (we go thru 5 a day in winter); \$22 buys a bag of chicken or duck feed; \$28 buys one 50 lb. bag of horse feed (we go thru 1 a day); and \$150 buys enough cat food for a week. **We are thankful that the plea in the prior newsletter for cat food brought in many cases, and always need more.** We typically go thru 1.5 – 2 cases of food per day! This is a very expensive undertaking!

As we've said before, the Board members feel blessed to have the chance to help the animals on their journey through Life. Our gift in return – unconditional love – is a priceless treasure that is only understood by the heart. The English philosopher Jeremy Bentham stated it perfectly: "The question is not 'Can they reason?' nor 'Can they talk?', but rather 'Can they suffer?'" With our 24 years of intense interaction with these creatures, the answer is a resounding - and sorrowful - YES.

ALL WE WANT FOR CHRISTMAS IS A WARM LAP!


Our beautiful “former kittens” need a warm and loving home. They are all spayed or neutered, vetted and up to date on vaccines, and socialized.


